President-Elect II Position:

1. Practicing gynecologic oncology for ≥ 10 years
2. Prior service on the SGO Board of Directors
3. Proven leadership experience within the SGO or similar organizations.
4. Administrative leadership and management experience in their respective professional settings
5. Strong communication and interpersonal skills.
6. Strategic planning and organizational management abilities.
7. Experience in consensus-building and conflict resolution.
8. Ability to represent the Society to external stakeholders, including the medical community, public, and media.

Secretary-Treasurer Elect Position:

1. Practicing gynecologic oncology for ≥ 10 years
2. Prior service on the SGO Board of Directors
3. Experience in financial management, budgeting, and reporting.
4. Ability to communicate financial information clearly to the Board and membership.
5. Commitment to integrity and transparency in all financial matters.

Members-at-Large Position:

1. Must be an SGO member in good standing.
2. Must demonstrate commitment to the SGO, its mission, members, services, policies and programs.
3. Must be able to commit the time and engagement for the proposed office and participate in a dependable and timely manner.
4. Must have knowledge and/or experience sufficient to effectively serve as an officer or member of a national, not-for-profit organization.
5. May also possess other applicable business skills/strategic relations that would be valuable to SGO.
