## **President-Elect II Position:**

- 1. Practicing gynecologic oncology for >/= 10 years
- 2. Prior service on the SGO Board of Directors
- 3. Proven leadership experience within the SGO or similar organizations.
- 4. Administrative leadership and management experience in their respective professional settings
- 5. Strong communication and interpersonal skills.
- 6. Strategic planning and organizational management abilities.
- 7. Experience in consensus-building and conflict resolution.
- 8. Ability to represent the Society to external stakeholders, including the medical community, public, and media.

## **Secretary-Treasurer Elect Position:**

- 1. Practicing gynecologic oncology for >/= 10 years
- 2. Prior service on the SGO Board of Directors
- 3. Experience in financial management, budgeting, and reporting.
- 4. Ability to communicate financial information clearly to the Board and membership.
- 5. Commitment to integrity and transparency in all financial matters.

## **Members-at-Large Position:**

- 1. Must be an SGO member in good standing.
- 2. Must demonstrate commitment to the SGO, its mission, members, services, policies and programs.
- 3. Must be able to commit the time and engagement for the proposed office and participate in a dependable and timely manner.
- 4. Must have knowledge and/or experience sufficient to effectively serve as an officer or member of a national, not-for-profit organization.
- 5. May also possess other applicable business skills/strategic relations that would be valuable to SGO.
